Star Airhart is one of our Algebra teachers at DBCS. She earned her BS degree in Math Education from James Madison University.

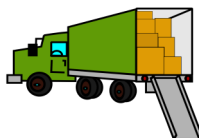


Star taught in Hampton public schools before coming to DBCS. She has worked at DBCS as an elementary aid, coach, study hall monitor, and math teacher.

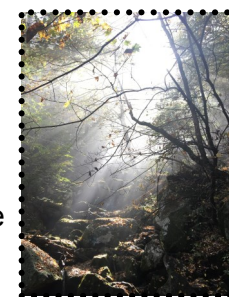
The church will provide not only statistical information from the past ten years but an anonymous congregational survey completed during a Sunday Morning Service.
